I hereby request permission to have an unattended power connection from the marina power supply module to my vessel.

The supply to my vessel will be connected to ONE portable device only, which will be: _____

Please ensure that the following basic conditions are met to ensure compliance with the Electrical Regulations AS/NZS 3004 and Marina Bylaws

- The supply lead must be one of continuous length (not exceeding 20m) and shall have a 16 Amp IEC60309 (round pin) plug for connection to the marina power supply
- The lead shall be appropriately rated for the demand put on it by the appliance
- The lead shall be shown to meet the relevant NZ Standard and have been tested to that requirement
- Cables are to be laid in such a manner that they are prevented from being:
 - damaged due to friction
 - a tripping hazard to people accessing the pier
- The supply lead shall be arranged to:
 - minimise the possibility of accidental disconnection (the cable shall be restrained at both ends)
 - to allow normal movement of the vessel without stress on the power lead
 - ensure lead and appliance can not fall in the water.

As owner/agent for the above vessel, I confirm that I have read the above and that the power lead will be connected to one appliance only (not through the vessels onboard power system) and accept all charges for being permanently plugged into the marina power modules
